our team which now comprises not just GPs and Practice
Nurses /Advanced Practice Nurses but has also expanded
to include Care Coordinators, Clinical Pharmacists,
Dieticians, First Contact Practitioners, Paramedics, Health
& Wellbeing Coaches, Mental Health Practitioners, and

Physician Associates & Social Prescribing Link Workers. By working together as a network and with the additional team roles, the 3 practices are able to offer increased services at scale

And last but not least – we have been singled out for praise by the NHS Immunisation Team

In the newsletter from the NHS England Immunisation Team, Davenport House has been commended this year for making significant strides in our uptake of flu immunisations for the under 65 at risk group and for the under 5 at risk group. We achieved 63% uptake for both groups (West Herts average is 50% and 24% respectively).
